Highlights of the March 14 Board Meeting:

There were 21 Board members, 4 staff, and 4 guests present.

The Board approved the following motions:

- To have a VBS Giving Tree in the Gathering Area to collect items needed for 2023 VBS in June.
- To allow the International Affairs Seminar sponsored by the Christian Church in Ohio to use our building as their host site for their 2024 trip.
- To purchase two microphones for a total of \$1,678 using funds from the Legacy Non-Budget Account.
- The use of Continuing Education Funds in the amount of \$1,719.28 to cover the cost of Pastors Sarah and Shelby attending the General Assembly in July in Louisville, KY.
- To move the remaining balance of \$228.17 in the CD Ministry Fund to the IT Special Fund closing the CD Ministry Fund.
- To create a committee to negotiate an agreement with the Wadsworth City Schools to rent classrooms in our Education Building for the 2023-2024 school year to accommodate the needs of a K-4 Alternative School of up to 20 children with behavioral disabilities.
